POINTS TO REMEMBER

1. Students should report to the school **at 8.30 am. to 10.45 am.**
2. Students will not be allowed to bring their text books or note books to the school during the examination days. In case if anyone brings the books to clarify their doubts, they should leave their bags in the ground 15 minutes before entering the examination hall.
3. In the examination hall, the students are requested to read thoroughly the question paper before they attempt to write the answers. 10 to 15 mts. could be granted for the same.
4. The students should leave the margin and write the name and other particulars properly in capital letters. Before starting the exam invigilators should announce in the class the number of pages in the question paper.
5. The students are not allowed to use any unfair means in the examination. Any student caught for using unfair means should be immediately reported to the Principal. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against any person found indulging in any malpractice in the examination hall.
6. On examination days students should come in proper uniform with their ID Cards. Defaulters will not be allowed to sit for the exam.
